Information to participant regarding risk of injury

Any and all recreation activities involve the risk of injury. You, as the participant, must be aware of the particular risks involved in the activity you have signed up for. For example, a softball player runs the risk of breaking an arm while diving for a ball or being struck by a thrown ball; a calligraphy student may fall and break a bone while walking out of class or to their chair; an excursion participant may trip and fall from the bus or the bus itself may be involved in an accident. In any event, participants must understand that all activities have the potential for any injury and Cornerstone is not liable. Participants must understand and agree that they take part in the activity as their own risk.

**AGREEMENT, WAIVER AND RELEASE**

In consideration for being permitted by the above church to participate in the above activity, I hereby waive, release and discharge any and all claims for damages for personal injury, death, or property damage which I may have, or which may hereafter accrue to me, as a result of participation in said activity. This release is intended to discharge in advance the above church (its officers, employees, and agents) from any and all liability arising out of, or connected in any way with my participation in said activity, even though that liability may arise out of negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities mentioned above. It is understood that this activity involves an element of risk and danger of accidents and knowing those risks, I hereby assume those risks. It is further agreed that this waiver, release and assumption of risk is to be binding on my heirs and assigns. I agree to indemnify and to hold the above persons or entities free and harmless from any loss, liability, damage, cost or expense which they may incur as the result of my death or any injury or property damage that I may sustain while participating in said activity.

# Cornerstone Adult Sports Programs Players Code of Conduct

The term PLAYER as used in the PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT shall apply to all team personnel,, such as manager, coaches, scorekeepers, sponsors, etc.

Any player being placed on probation for the remainder of the season and reported again for violating the “Code Of Conduct” will be suspended for the remainder of the season. Cornerstone reserves the right to refuse any rostered player who has continually violated “Code Of Conduct” from any and all further events on campus.

Any player removed from a game must leave the facility immediately, failure to do so will carry a maximum penalty of suspension for the remainder of the season.

- Sec 1: NO PLAYER SHALL: At any time lay a hand upon, push, shove, strike, or threaten to strike an official.  
PENALTY: Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report such player to the league. Such player will remain suspended until his/her case has been considered by the league executive committee.
- Sec 2: NO PLAYER SHALL: Refuse to abide by official's decision.  
PENALTY: Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report such player to the league. Such player will remain suspended until his/her case has been considered by the league executive committee.
- Sec 3: NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of objectionable demonstrations by throwing balls, gloves, bats, or any other forceful action.  
PENALTY: The degree of infraction of this tenet of good sportsmanship shall in the official's judgment draw a minimum penalty of warning or a maximum penalty of removal from the game. Official's are required to immediately suspend from further play, any player who throws a bat in an unsportsmanlike manner.
- Sec 4: NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of heaping personal, verbal abuse upon any official for any real or imaginary wrong decision judgment.  
PENALTY: Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report such player to the league. Such player shall remain suspended until his/her case has been considered by the league executive committee.
- Sec 5: NO PLAYER SHALL: Discuss with an official in any manner the decision reached by such official except the manager or coach.  
PENALTY: The degree of infraction of this tenet of good sportsmanship's shall in the officials judgment, draw a minimum penalty of warning or a maximum penalty of removal from the game.
- Sec 6: NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of using unnecessarily rough tactics in the play of the game against the body and person of an opposing player.  
PENALTY: Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play.
- Sec 7: NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of physical attack as an aggressor, upon any player, official or spectator.  
PENALTY: Officials are required to immediately suspend the player from further play and report such player to the league. Such player shall remain suspended until his/her case has been considered by the league executive committee.
- Sec 8: NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of abusive verbal attack upon any player, official or spectator.  
PENALTY: The degree of infraction of this tenet of good sportsmanship's shall in the officials judgment, draw a minimum penalty of warning or a maximum penalty of removal from the game.
- Sec 9: NO PLAYER SHALL: Use profane, obscene, or vulgar language in any manner or at any time.  
PENALTY: The degree of infraction of this tenet of good sportsmanship's shall in the officials judgment, draw a minimum penalty of warning or a maximum penalty of removal from the game
- Sec 10: NO PLAYER SHALL: Appear on the field of play at any time in an intoxicated condition. Cornerstone prohibits the use of alcoholic beverages or controlled substances or anything that detracts from a Christian atmosphere.  
PENALTY: Officials are required to immediately suspend player from play and report it to the league for further consideration.
- Sec 11: NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of gambling upon any play or the outcome of the game with any spectator, player or opponent.  
PENALTY: Officials are required to report violations of this rule to the league.
- Sec 12: NO PLAYER SHALL: Smoke while going on or coming off the field or play or while on the field of play. Smoking any where on campus is prohibited.  
PENALTY: Officials are required to warn players guilty of infraction of this rule, and failure of such players to comply will result in removal from the game.
- Sec 13: NO PLAYER SHALL: Be guilty of discussing publicly with the spectators in a derogatory or abusive manner any play , decision, or personal opinion of other players during the game.  
PENALTY: Officials are required to warn player guilty of infraction of this rule, and failure of such players to comply will result in removal from the game.
- Sec 14: NO PLAYER SHALL: Permit any one to remain in the dugout or on the player's bench during the game who is not a playing member of the team.  
PENALTY: Officials are required to warn members to the team guilty of violation of this rule. Failure on the part of team members to enforce this rule will result in team being reported to the league for further action.
- Sec 15: NO PLAYER SHALL: Wear clothing with slogans not consistent with Christian values.  
PENALTY: Officials will request player to turn clothing inside out or change/remove all together. Failure on the part of team members to enforce this rule will result in team being reported to the league for further action.
- Sec 16: NO PLAYER SHALL: Allow under aged children to be unattended in other areas of the campus. Children and family need to remain in designated seating or play areas.  
PENALTY: Officials are required to warn members to the team guilty of violation of this rule. Failure on the part of team members to enforce this rule will result in team being reported to the league for further action.
